At MiChild Group, we are committed to protecting the privacy and security of our children, families, and staff. We only collect and use personal information when it is necessary to provide high-quality childcare, meet legal requirements, and ensure the safety and wellbeing of every child.

What information do we collect? We may collect information about children and parents, including contact details, emergency contacts, attendance records, health and medical information, dietary requirements, development records, and information required for funding purposes.

How do we use your information? We use personal information to:

- Provide safe and effective care for your child.
- Support your child's learning and development.
- Communicate with parents and carers.
- Manage nursery funding and fees.
- Meet safeguarding, welfare, and legal requirements.
- Share information with schools to support transitions, where appropriate.

Who do we share information with?

We only share information when necessary and in accordance with the law. This may include local authorities, regulatory bodies such as Ofsted, and schools to support children's learning and development. We ensure that any organisation we share information with handles it securely and responsibly.

How do we keep information safe?

We take appropriate measures to protect personal information and ensure it is stored securely. We only keep information for as long as necessary to fulfil our legal and operational responsibilities.

Your rights Under data protection law, you have the right to:

- Access the personal information we hold about you and your child.
- Request corrections to inaccurate information.
- Request deletion of information where appropriate.
- Restrict or object to certain types of processing.
- Withdraw consent where processing is based on consent.
